Best Practices Pilot & Crew Checklist



This checklist was originally developed for world championship flying and included as part of the U.S. team Best Practices series. This copy has been substantially modified for domestic use. PLEASE NOTE & UNDERSTAND: Checklists need to be updated for each individual's circumstances and that errors and omissions in this checklist are the responsibility of the user.

Tires checked for air and wear Bearing grease check (COBRA have sealed bearings) Spare tire, check pressure Jack & lug wrench Lug key for rims if installed Trailer plug diagram Trailer ball and hitch (check size and confirm if renting) Locks for trailer hitch & trailer tongue Glider inspect and secure including cockpit Glider spares stowed and secure for sea shipment Tail dolly secure Wing stand(s) in trailer and secure Wing wheel in trailer and secure Tow out bar in trailer and secure Wheel chocks Trailer tiedowns (rope, takes and sledge hammer) All doors locked (extra key location) Lights functioning (spare lamps) Trailer electrical plug Electrical wire, tape and connectors for splicing Rain gear and mud shoes are handy to have in trailer front Garbage bags
